So You Want to Hire A Professional Genealogist?

Congratulations! Now is the time to formulate a clear research objective. Approaching a genealogist with the task of researching your entire family tree can be expensive and time consuming. Instead create a smaller achievable task, such as, "Who were my great grandparents?" or "Help me document my Revolutionary War patriot ancestor."

Results are never guaranteed in genealogy. Sometimes our elusive ancestors left little evidence of their existence. In other cases, records have been lost due to time or disaster. I never know what I may or may not find when I start researching. I will strive to conduct a reasonably exhaustive search to fulfill my client's needs. I am a member of several genealogy societies as well as the Association of Professional Genealogists.
